
# ARCHBISHOP OSWALD THOMAS COLMAN GOMIS, FORMER FABC SECRETARY GENERAL

In 1995 he was appointed by St. Pope John Paul II as Bishop of Anuradhapura, Sri Lanka. He was appointed by the same Pope as Archbishop of Colombo, Sri Lanka in 2002. Pope Benedict XVI accepted his retirement in 2009 at the age of 76. He was a priest for 65 and a bishop for over 54 years.

He was an FABC Standing Committee Member from 1972 to 1978. He was the Bishop Chairman of the Office of Social Communications 1974-1982. He was the President of the Catholic Bishop' Conference of Sri Lanka from 1998 to 2005. As a President of Bishop Conference, he was a member of the FABC Central Committee. He was the FABC Secretary General from 2000 to 2005. He attended the Second Plenary Assembly in 1978 in Calcutta, India, the Third Plenary Assembly in 1982 at Samphran, Thailand, the Seventh Plenary Assembly in 2000 again in Samphran, Thailand, and the Eighth Plenary Assembly in 2004 at Daejeon, South Korea.


#### FATHER CATALINO AREVALO, SJ, DIES AT 97



A prominent Filipino Jesuit priest theologian, Fr. Catalino Arevalo, died early morning of Wednesday, January 18, 2023 three months before his 98th birthday. He had served the FABC as a theological resource person right from the very beginning at the Asian Bishops' Meeting in 1970. He was the convenor and a member of the Theological Advisory Commission (TAC), now the Office of Theological Concerns (OTC). He was the first Asian on the Holy See's International Theological Commission from 1974 to 1986. He drafted the FABC statement in 1974 at the first Plenary Assembly. That statement is the significant "Evangelization in Modern Day Asia," which introduced the hallmark triple dialogue, dialogue with cultures, dialogue with religions and dialogue with the poor. We mourn his passing while we gratefully acknowledge his substantial contribution to the FABC from its very beginning.

#### ASIAN CONTINENTAL ASSEMBLY ON SYNODALITY

The Asian Continental Assembly on Synodality was held at Baan Phu Waan, the Pastoral Training Center of the Bangkok Archdiocese 25-27 February 2023. There were 90 participants including those from the Synod Secretariat in Rome such as Cardinal Mario Grech, Sr. Nathalie Becquart and Cardinal Jean Claude Hollerich. Cardinal Charles Bo, Cardinal Oswald Gracias and Cardinal Joseph Coutts who are the Asians on the Synod Council also participated. The Final Document coming from the Asian Continental Assembly on Synodality was submitted to the General Secretariat for the Synod on 16 March 2023 after it had been validated by the Central Committee on 3 March 2023.



#### LAUNCHING OF THE FABC 50 GENERAL CONFERENCE FINAL DOCUMENT
