FR. JOHN A. CIOPPA, MM FIRST "ASSISTANT SECRETARY GENERAL"



FABC OFFICE OF EVANGELIZATION GATHERING OF ECCLESIAL MOVEMENTS IN ASIA

The FABC Office of Evangelization held a Gathering of Ecclesial Movements in Asia from 25th to 27th August 2023 in Bangkok, Thailand. The gathering comprised of 54 delegates representing 23 ecclesial movements and communities from across 14 countries. The main theme was 'Towards a New Commitment to the 'Great Commandment' and 'Great Commission'. The gathering addressed the following themes: Synodality in the context of the mission of Ecclesial Movements in Asia. Preparing for the Silver Jubilee of the Apostolic Exhortation Ecclesia in Asia and for the 10th Anniversary of Pope Francis' Evangelii Gaudium. Developing a vision and working on evangelization strategies to celebrate 2033 - the 2000th year of the death and resurrection of Jesus, the birthday of our Mother Church, and the 2000th Anniversary of the 'Great Commission'.

SYNODAL FORMATION

The FABC through the Office of Laity and Family, Office of the Clergy, Office of the Consecrated Life, Office of Education and Faith Formation and the Office of Theological Concerns held the First Consultation Meeting on Synodal Formation in Asia on September 11-15, 2023 in Pattaya, Thailand. There were 72 delegates from 17 countries in Asia comprised of 9 bishops, 23 lay (women 15, men 8), 23 consecrated persons (women 7, ordained men 16), and 17 clergy, gathered to discern the vision, characteristics, and approaches of synodal formation based on the Bangkok Document of the FABC 50 General Conference, the Final Document of the Asian Continental Assembly on Synodality, and the Instrumentum Laboris of the XVI General Assembly of the Synod of Bishops.
