FABC PAPERS NO. 196

The Synodal Assembly on the Mission of the Christian Family in Asia organized by the Office of Laity and Family and held in the Camillian Center 11-15 June 2026 addressed the themes of *Familiaris Consortio* and *Amoris Laetitia*, the Word of God and the Family and BECs. MEETING OF THE FABC OFFICES.

The Chairmen and Executive Secretaries of the FABC Offices and of the Committee on Synodality met online on June 8, 2026. In the discussion led by the Central Secretariat, the Officers shared with one another how they have been implementing the programs that they shared during their meeting with the Central Committee last February. Notable was the growing impetus to collaborate with one another in the spirit of synodality. This fosters sensible creativity, transparency, and accountability in view of animating the FABC Members for a more effective mission in Asia. The Central Secretariat then updated the Officers regarding their roles in the XII Plenary Assembly that will be held in Jakarta next month.

SYNODAL ASSEMBLY ON THE MISSION OF THE CHRISTIAN FAMILY IN ASIA TODAY

The FABC-OLF *Synodal Assembly on the Mission of Christian Family in Asia Today* was held at the Camillian Pastoral Centre (Bangkok, Thailand) from 11 to 15 May 2026. The invitees were FABC Leadership, FABC OLF Chairman, Members, and Executive Secretary; Chairmen and Executive Secretaries of the episcopal conferences' offices on laity, family, life, youth, women, and BEC animation. The 45 participants were from 11 Conferences.

The general objective was to listen to what the Holy Spirit is saying regarding the mission of the Christian family in the Church and in Asian societies today (cf. Rev 3:22). The first day, the theme was "Celebrating". The Assembly started with an Opening Eucharist presided by Cardinal Tarcisio Isao Kikuchi, SVD, Secretary General of FABC. On the first day, the FABC Member conferences gave



reports in which they shared the following questions, and were later followed by conversation in the Spirit and group reports. 1. How was Pope Francis' *Amoris Laetitia* received in your conference/diocese? 2. How are you implementing the Catechumenal Pathways for Married Life? (lessons learned and success stories) 3. How are you making family life ministry more synodal? How are the commissions on laity, family, life, youth, women, BECs, elderly, et al. collaborating? It was truly an enriching moment to listen to each another and sense how the Holy Spirit is working and at the same time challenging us in our concrete reality regarding the Christian family in Asia today. On the second day, under the theme of "Discerning", in the morning, Fr. Vimal Tirimanna CSsR, gave two talks us on *Familiaris Consortio* and *Amoris Laetitia*: controversial issues and theological developments (first part) and pastoral prospects (second part) followed by an open forum. In the afternoon, Cardinal Pablo Virgilio David, Vice-President of FABC, shared two talks on *The Family and the Word of God*, also followed by open forum. Archbishop Francis Xavier Vira Arpondratana, Archbishop of Bangkok, came to preside over the Eucharist on the second day. The last day of the OLF Synodal Assembly was under the theme "Heeding the Holy Spirit". In the morning, there was a panel discussion on the *Bangkok Document's* agenda, with the following themes and speakers: -Family: Fr. Enrico Emmanuel Ayo (Philippines) -Youth: Fr. Nigel Barrett (India) -Women: Ms. Anna Teresa Amandus (Malaysia) -BECs: Fr Vimal Tirimanna, CSsR. (Sri Lanka). After their talks, there was a conversation in the Spirit on each of the above topics. In the afternoon, there were group reports, plenary conversations, and

synthesis. The Synodal Assembly concluded with a Eucharist presided over by Bishop Emmanuel Rozario of Barishal, Bangladesh, and Chairman of the FABC's OLF. Encouraged by this Synodal Assembly, it is hoped that all may continue to support and learn from one another as we together journey forward in our respective ministries.

OTC: A SYNODAL THEOLOGIZING COMMUNITY

The FABC Office of Theological Concerns (OTC) met in Jakarta, Indonesia, 3-10 May 2026. The Bishops' Conference of Indonesia hosted them. The OTC is unique in that each Bishops' Conference sends one theologian to the OTC who has a 4-year term of service unless extended for another 4 years by their Bishops' Conference. They can call their way of theologizing in OTC as 'synodal'. Firstly, they witness to inclusivity as they hail from different countries, ensuring that voices, cultures, and wisdom from the different regions of Asia find space in this diverse community of theologians. This synodal style is most evident during the annual one-week meeting. Every day they pray together, share the Word of God, and celebrate Eucharist. Connecting deeply in discernment, they start by sharing their different contexts and the challenges they are facing, listening to God in the signs of the times. In this way, they hope they really are, as the Synod says, 'walking with humanity', with the joys and pains of our Asian peoples. They choose a topic to discuss before coming to a country, and a few of them and one local theologian write and present a paper to one another. Then an open discussion ensues. This year in Jakarta, the topic was Vatican II and Synodality. They chose one theological insight from a Vatican II document and studied how this was treated by the Final Document of the Synod. Estela Padilla did Local Church (*Lumen Gentium*), Archbishop Midyphil Billones, Ordained Ministry (*PRESBYTERORUM ORDINIS*), and Sr Rekha Chenattu, Revelation (*Dei Verbum*). Their newest project is to prepare a formation module, rather than the usual theological paper, to make Synodality better understood and practiced in leadership communities (clergy and lay, commissions, SCCs, and Pastoral Councils, etc.). For input and reflection, they added our Asian cultural values to the Synodal teachings on communion, participation, and mission. It has biblical reflections and a guide for Conversation in the Spirit to help people seek conversion that leads to commitment in living synodality in their local settings.

CONTINENTAL BODIES MEET WITH THE GENERAL SECRETARIAT OF THE SYNOD

Cardinal Mario Grech called for a meeting of the Presidents of the Continental Associations of Bishops' Conferences with the point person for implementation of the synod and the Secretary General. This was held at the offices of the General Secretariat for the Synod from 23 June to 25 June 2026. It concluded with the presence of Pope Leo XIV. Representing the FABC were Cardinal Filipe Neri Ferrao, Cardinal Pablo David, and Fr. William LaRousse.
